Each Month Neighborhood Watch Information will continue to be published in an ongoing effort to keep our community informed on crime watch matters.

During the last half of APRIL to the present date of May 15, 2010, based on Orange County Sheriff's crime statistics and individual reports there was TWO RESIDENTIAL burglaries: ONE EACH on MOORGATE 19600 block; and MARLIN 20200 block; Additionally, there were FIVE REPORTED AUTO burglaries; TWO on MAJESTIC 19700 block; TWO on BASTINGS 2100 block; ONE on BANCROFT 2100 block. And ONE AUTO THEFT on BANCROFT 5500 block. Also we have had a couple MAIL BOXES destroyed one on Maxim and one on Baker.

Preparing for a vacation, a weekend away from home or a business trip should be a pleasant experience for you and your family. You can make each trip more enjoyable and enhance your security if you will take a few easy steps to reduce the possibility that your home will be burglarized or vandalized while you are away.

It starts with the exterior – paper delivery, mail delivery, and grass cutting all need to be tended to while away. A trusted neighbor looking after the items may be the solution although the mail and paper can both be held until your return. Have a friend park their car in your driveway.

Next an interior timer to turn lights on at night and off during the day helps show that the home is occupied. Be sure that the last one out of the home has secured all appliances and locked all windows, doors and secured the garage door. Making your home a TOUGH TARGET pays off.

Lastly notify Neighborhood Watch and/or the C.O.P. coordinator of your plans.
