

#### **NEWS AND VIEWS ON HEALTH & LIFE INSURANCE – JUNE 2023**

#### 1. WHAT HAPPENS WHEN COVID-19 EMERGENCY DECLARATIONS END?

- a. THE BIDEN ADMINISTRATION ANNOUNCED ITS INTENTION TO END THE NATIONAL PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY DECLARATIONS ON MAY 11, 2023.
- b. THESE EMERGENCY DECLARATIONS HAVE BEEN IN PLACE SINCE EARLY 2020. THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT HAD THE FLEXIBILITY TO WAIVE OR MODIFY CERTAIN CONDITIONS IN MEDICARE, MEDICAID. AND CHIP AND IN PRIVATE GROUP AND INDIVIDUAL HEALTH INSURANCE PLANS.
- c. THE EARLY DAYS OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC WERE MARKED BY SEVERAL EMERGENCY DECLARATIONS MADE BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, UNDER SEVERAL BROAD AUTHORITIES.
- d. VACCINES, TEST KITS, ANTI-VIRAL TREATMENTS, AND HOSPITALIZATIONS WERE PROVIDED AT NO COST PER THE MANDATES OF THE PANDEMIC.
- e. WITH THE END OF THE PANDEMIC EMERGENCY DECLARATION ON MAY 11, 2023, ALL COVID-19 CARE AND TREATMENT WILL LIKELY BE PAID FOR BY THE CONSUMER'S INSURANCE THROUGH CO-PAYS, COINSURANCE, AND DEDUCTIBLES JUST LIKE ANY INJURY OR ILLNESS COVERED BY HEALTH INSURANCE.
- f. CONSUMERS ARE ADVISED TO CALL THE TOLL-FREE NUMBER ON THE INSURANCE HEALTH ID CARD FOR SPECIFIC INFORMATION ON HOW THEIR PLAN COVERS COVID-RELATED MATTERS.

#### 2. UPDATE ON HEALTH INSURANCE OPEN ENROLLMENT DATES:

- a. MEDICARE OPEN ENROLLMENT ENDED MARCH 31ST.
- b. MEDICARE ANNUAL ENROLLMENT PERIOD STARTS OCTOBER 15 THROUGH DECEMBER 7TH EVERY YEAR.
- c. SPECIAL ELECTION PERIODS FOR MEDICARE AND U-65 CONSUMERS ARE AVAILABLE FOR 12 MONTHS OF THE YEAR. AN EXPERIENCED HEALTH AGENT CAN PROVIDE DETAILS ON THESE CONDITIONS.
- d. U-65 CONSUMERS WITH FPL INCOMES BETWEEN 100% TO 150% CAN MAKE PLAN CHANGES AND ENROLL IN ANY MONTH.
- e. THE FLORIDA DCF WITH ACCESS FLORIDA IS CONDUCTING MEDICAID REDETERMATION. FAMILIES RECEIVING THESE LETTERS ARE ADVISED TO RESPOND TO REQUESTS FOR INFORMATION, OR LOSS OF MEDICAID/CHIP COVERAGE WILL RESULT.
- f. FAMILIES THAT ARE FACED WITH LOSS OF MEDICAID OR CHIP COVERAGE ARE ADVISED TO IMMEDIATELY CONTACT AN EXPERIENCED HEALTH AGENT AS THERE ARE SOLUTIONS TO LOSS OF COVERAGE.

#### 3. WHAT IS FOREIGN TRAVEL INSURANCE?

- a. MEDICARE AND PRIVATE HEALTH INSURANCE IS NOT DESIGNED TO PROVIDE COVERAGE OUT OF THE US.
- b. TRAVEL ON A CRUISE SHIP PAST THE 3-MILE LIMIT IS CONSIDERED FOREIGN TRAVEL.
- c. THERE IS A DIFFERENCE BETWEEN MAJOR MEDICAL FOREIGN TRAVEL INSURANCE AND INDEMNITY FOREIGN TRAVEL INSURANCE OFFERED BY TRAVEL AGENTS AND CRUISE LINES.
- d. THE GOLD STANDARD FOR FOREIGN TRAVEL INSURANCE IS ZERO DEDUCTIBLE WITH \$1,000,000 COVERAGE INCLUDING UP TO \$500,000 OF EMERGENCY AIR AMBULANCE.
- e. INDEMNITY INSURANCE MEANS THE CONSUMER PAYS THE PROVIDER AND SEEKS TO BE REIMBURSED FIRST BY THEIR HEALTH INSURANCE PROVIDER AND THEN BY THE INDEMNITY PROVIDER.
- f. INDEMNITY INSURANCE MAY PROVIDE 180-DAY PRE-EXISTING CONDITION UNDERWRITING AND EXCLUSIONS FOR TERRORISM AND ACTS OF WARFARE. MAJOR MEDICAL FOREIGN TRAVEL INSURANCE DOES NOT CONTAIN UNDERWRITING OR EXCLUSIONS FOR DESTINATIONS, TERRORISM, OR ACTS OF WAR.
- g. IF TRAVELING OUT OF THE US, CONSULT WITH A KNOWLEDGABLE HEALTH AGENT FOR ADVICE ON FOREIGN TRAVEL TRIP INSURANCE.

## HOME IGNITION ZONE CHECKLIST

SIMPLE STEPS FROM ROOF TO FOUNDATION TO MAKE A HOME SAFER FROM EMBERS AND RADIANT HEAT

- Clean roofs and gutters of dead leaves, debris and pine needles that could catch embers
- Replace or repair any loose or missing shingles or roof tiles to prevent ember penetration
- Reduce embers that could pass through vents in the eaves by installing 1/8 inch metal mesh screening
- Clean debris from exterior attic vents and install 1/8 inch metal mesh screening to reduce embers
- Repair or replace damaged or loose window screens and any broken windows
- Screen or box-in areas below patios and decks with wire mesh to prevent debris and combustible materials from accumulating
- Move any flammable material away from wall exteriors - mulch, flammable plants, leaves and needles, firewood piles - anything that can burn
- Remove anything stored underneath decks or porches

JUST WATCH and REPORT

During the last half of APRIL to the present date of MAY 10, 2023, based on Orange County Sheriff's crime statistics and individual reports not yet reflected in the statistics, there was one automobile theft in the 2500 block of Alabaster. There were no other property crimes reported.

In Real Estate, they say Location, Location, Location. Here in Wedgefield, given the current conditions, we need to promote LOCK-UP, LOCK-UP, and LOCK-UP. Unlocked vehicles and open garage doors are crimes of opportunity available for even those individuals who would never steal – unless tempted.

History shows that IF YOUR CAR IS NOT LOCKED, IT WILL BE SEARCHED, and IF THE KEY IS FOUND, IT WILL GO FOR A RIDE, and the "BAG IT" rule works. As we approach the summer vacation time, we are going to see more juvenile issues. Autos need to be locked and, above all, practice the "Bag It" rule, where you bag all valuables and take them from the vehicle with you both at work and home.

Summertime is great, and the activities are calling. Youths often ride a "found" bicycle to get to a desired destination, then leave it for the next opportunist to take it to another destination. Whether the bike was carelessly left in the yard or stolen makes no difference. The now discarded bike is noticed by a responsible resident, and a call to OCSO is made, and the deputy

tries to match the serial number with a reported theft of a bike. The bike could return if the owner noted the serial number and put it in the theft report. The serial number is located in one of the following places; underside of the crank, headset label, rear stays, seat down tube next to crank, and top of the crank.

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
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

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

#### **OPEN BURNING RULES**

WHERE THERE'S SMOKO B THERE'SAIR POLLUTION



Residential open burning is restricted in Orange County because it produces smoke that is harmful to our health.



#### In accordance with county rules, burning the following is restricted:

- Yard waste, tree cuttings, untreated wood and other vegetative debris.
- Household garbage and paper waste, including confidential documents.
- · Medications and biological waste.
- · Hazardous waste such as mercurycontaining materials, plastics, tires and rubber, residual oil, used oil and pesticide containers.



• Construction waste such as asbestos, tar, asphalt, roofing material and treated wood.

#### PET AND ANIMAL RULES OPEN DISCUSSION, JUNE 15TH

At the monthly Community meeting on June 15th, 7PM at 20550 Maxim, we will have

open discussion about the pet and animal rules that <u>currently govern all properties in Wedgefield</u> (whether a renter or homeowner, HOA member or not). We encourage you to attend the meeting and join the discussion, which will be used to consider changes.
PET AND ANIMAL RULES, SELECTED FROM HOA CODES AND COVENANTS:
<ul> <li>Only dogs, cats, and other generally recognizable household pets may be kept on the Lots.</li> <li>These pets must be reasonable in number.</li> </ul>
☐ The Association shall have the sole right to designate what types of animals are classified as "household pets" and what is a reasonable number of pets, taking into account the size of the pet owner's Lot.
□ Dogs shall be on a leash at all times when off the Lot; however, dogs may be off leash when in a fenced and secured yard.
☐ Pet owners must clear and remove any fecal deposits made by their pets from any and all areas.
☐ Breeding of animals for commercial purposes is prohibited.
☐ Horses are allowed in the Estates area only. One horse is permitted for the first two contiguous acres and one horse per acre thereafter.
$\square$ A homeowner can apply for an HOA variance for animals outside of these rules.
Common issues seen currently:
<ol> <li>Too many horses for the lot size, and too many dogs for one property.</li> <li>Chickens, without both an HOA variance and an Orange County permit (see below).</li> <li>Roosters – not allowed by Deed restrictions or by the Orange County permit rules.</li> <li>Animal businesses – violate our residential zoning and animal type/quantity rules.</li> <li>Breeding of animals – violates our residential zoning and animal quantity rules.</li> <li>Animals on vacant lots – animals must be on a lot with a single family residence.</li> <li>Animals other than dogs, cats, and horses on lots, without an HOA variance in place.</li> </ol>
Here are 3 County chicken rules; see all by Googling "ocfl municode 2021-34":
<b>Q: Based on the Ordinance, what are the basic criteria for having residential backyard chickens?</b> A: The basic criteria laid out in the Ordinance include: \$57 permit required up to four (4) chickens for personal egg consumption; no sales of any kind allowed; no roosters or other poultry allowed; no onsite breeding, slaughtering or consumption of chickens; proof of training required from UF/IFAS Extension Orange County; coop and pen standards required; and care and keeping standards required.
Q: Does the Ordinance override private covenants and restrictions, such as within HOAs or PDs? A: No. You must comply with the private covenants and restrictions of HOAs and

Q: What if I am a renter? A: At this time, the permit is available to owner-occupied residences on properly zoned properties only. No renters are permitted to have backyard chickens.
